PORT POSTS STRONGEST NOVEMBER IN 17 YEARS

The Port of Thunder Bay handled 1.2 million metric tonnes of cargo during the past month – the most for any November since 1998.

Grain shipments are surging in Thunder Bay. The 1 million metric tonnes of grain loaded for outbound shipment in November was 33% higher than the five-year-average for the month. This trend is expected to continue to the end of the shipping season in mid-January.

The biggest story in the Port over the last thirty days has been the number of ocean vessels. Known as 'Salties', ocean vessels typically load grain in Thunder Bay for direct export to destinations in Europe, North Africa, the Middle East and Latin America. Twenty-five Salties called the Port in November, a level reached only in one other month (May 2014) during the last 15 years. Six additional salties remain in Port for loading in December, with more to come.

Salty loadings contributed significantly to the strong grain volumes in November. 40% of all grain shipped during the month departed on Salties, roughly two times the normal share.

It was also a strong month for potash and dry bulk shipments in Thunder Bay. Outbound loadings of potash were much stronger than average and are now on-par with 2014 volumes.
